

Surf Safe Days

Both Stonewall (Year 6) and Clement's Inn (Year 5) are now having their Surf Safe Day TOMORROW Friday 9th September. Please ensure your child comes into school with a towel, swimwear (wetsuits will be provided) and a packed lunch and refillable drinks bottle. The class teachers have emailed a kit list. Children are back to school for normal pick up at 3pm.

2022 Adventure Days (AD)

Stonewall and Clement's Inn are having their AD together this year on Thursday 15th September. The cost of the AD is £15. Please note that there is a subsidy for pupil premium children. Children are spending Thursday on the beach and then camping overnight at Farm School. On Friday children are exploring Trebah Gardens and are back in school for a LATER pick up at 3.30pm. Full kit list, further information and consent forms will be sent out tomorrow, Friday 9th September. Consent forms need to be returned to school by Wednesday 14th September.

Global Boarders Surf Club - from NEXT Tuesday 13th September

Global Boarders are offering a KS2 after school Surf Club from next Tuesday 13th September. This club will run from Marazion (Follyfield car park) each week where possible but, if the waves are flat or the tide is wrong, then it will be bodyboarding or surf lifesaving. The cost is £15-£20 per session depending on the size of the group. Please contact Edna in the school office to sign your child up for the club and/or for further information.





Forest Fridays (FF)

A reminder that children and staff wear comfortable 'home clothes' on Forest/Beach Fridays. Please note that these need to be old clothes that they don't mind getting muddy and that cover up skin so that it is protected around the fire. Children and adults must wear clothes that are suitable for outdoor learning. Up until half term, children are taking their learning outdoors with their own class. After October half term, children in Reception and KS1 will have FF together on Friday morning and children in KS2 will have their FF together in the afternoon.

School Uniform Swap Shop

Thank you to everyone that is using our School Uniform Swap Shop to reduce our environmental impact. PE and School Sport
