#### Marazion School Academy Conversion

A reminder that the Department for Education (DfE) Regional Director has approved the academy conversion of Marazion School to join Crofty Education Trust (CET). We have also received an Academy Order from the DfE, which enables the school to convert to an academy. Marazion School is now working with the DfE, CET and Penwith Education Trust regarding 'onboarding' - the process of becoming an academy.

#### Marazion School Uniform - Swimming Trunks/Costumes

Marazion School uniform includes black swimming trunks (not board shorts) / swimming costumes as well as goggles and swimming caps. The reason for standardising the swimwear is to maintain consistency in our school uniform, prevent distractions and ensure children are wearing suitable clothing for safety and to improve swimming technique. School provides swimming caps and goggles but please note that school can also provide black trunks or swimming costumes if you are unable to source either of them.

PE Days: Moana (Year R/1): Thursday; Franklin: Year 2 is Monday and Thursday / Year 3 is Monday and Wednesday; Mercury (Year 4/5): Monday and Wednesday; Mitchell (Year 5/6): Wednesday and Friday. Fixtures and Events: Some KS2 children have a Cross Country event next week, letters have already gone out. See below for date and time. Swimming Sessions: Some Year 3 children and some continuing swimmers in Year 4, 5 and 6 are swimming this half term. A text will go out on Mondays to parents/carers as a reminder. There is a LATER pick up after swimming, which is 4pm. Please note that we are now asking for children to be picked up from the main playground gate @ 4pm. Thanks. Children need swimming kit (black costume or rash vest/trunks - not board shorts) and goggles (if you have them) as well as a £1 contribution towards the cost of the sessions. School provides swimming caps. Thanks. Gym Sessions: Children in Mercury (Year 4/5) are going to Penzance Gym on Mondays this half term. Children need to wear a t-shirt that has no buttons to the gym. Thanks. Optional PE Homework: For January, we are asking you to go on a walk and play Winter Walk Bingo (WWB) - an example of WWB is attached to this newsletter. If you want to create your own WWB, the School Office have some blank WWB grids.
