## 2024 Marazion Parade of Lights / Lights Switch On - Next Friday 6th December

A reminder that everyone is invited to join the 'Marazion Parade of Lights' that will lead from St Michaels Mount to the 'Christmas Tree Big Switch On' next Friday 6<sup>th</sup> of December at 6pm. The Parade of Lights will leave St Michael's Mount (SMM) at 3.45pm to walk across the Causeway towards the Godolphin. If you want to join the parade, please pick up your child promptly at 3.15pm and head straight to SMM - there will be hot chocolate available. After that, in town, there are mince pies, carols and storytelling. Some children from Marazion School are singing by the tree from 5.20pm followed by carols led by Apollo Choir and the Lights Switch On at 6pm. Breage Band are playing around the Christmas tree too. There are also Christmas markets, more live music, Christmas trees, wreaths and lots of fun for the whole community.

#### St Michael's Mount (SMM) Sustainable Christmas Trees

Marazion School has been invited to discover the sustainable Christmas trees on SMM next Friday afternoon. All classes are visiting the Mount across the afternoon, children in Reception and KS1 first, followed by KS2 children.
