


MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 23rd May 2024

Household Support Fund - Final Reminder

The entitlement criteria for automatic payments from the Household Support Fund is changing. In order to be entitled to a payment from the Household Support Fund scheme in 2024, you must be responsible for at least one child and on 3rd June 2024 either: be entitled to Council Tax Support OR have been placed in emergency accommodation by the Council. You will receive £80 per child. If you are already in receipt of Council Tax Support, then you don't have to do anything else – you will receive your payment automatically. PE and School Sport
