Moana Class - Reception Curriculum Information - Spring 2025



Key Statement: How far will I go?

This half term's topic-based learning 'Travelling' has a geography focus with us naming and locating the world's seven continents. We are looking at maps and a globe to identify where we live and compare it to other countries around the world. We are drawing information from simple maps and devising our own maps.

Literacy - We are focusing on the story 'We're going on a bear hunt' and creating our own versions. We are focusing on non-fiction texts, writing phrases to describe what we might see when travelling around the world. In phonics, we are consolidating previous learnt sounds and practising reading word more fluently.

Maths - We are continuing to look at small numbers and representing them in various ways. We are finding out 1 more and 1 less than small numbers.

Physical Development - We are developing body strength, co-ordination and balance needed for dance, practising different dances from around the world for example Can - Can and Samba.

Expressive Arts and Design - We are developing our artistic skills using clay. We are moulding and shaping clay into famous landmarks as well creating our own models of interest inspired by ceramicists such as *Augusta Savage* and *Barbara Hepworth*.

Computing - We are using iPad to take photos and videos. We are using a program to practise our letter and number formation.

Music - We are learning songs about transport. We are also finding out about Samba and playing the Samba drums.

Outdoor Learning - We are visiting Lands End Airport to launch our travelling topic. We will be doing a scavenger hunt in Marazion and following simple maps around the school grounds. Woodland/Beach School is every Friday morning.

Home Learning

Children are expected to read every day and record this in their reading record. This is the homework for Reception and is very important, as it means children practise reading at home.
