

Multi Academy Trust Parents' Consultation - NEXT Monday 9th September

You may remember that we began the process of exploring multi-academy trusts (MAT) some time ago. All schools are likely to be trust-led in the not-too-distant future and we are determined to make the right decision for Marazion and its community whilst we have the opportunity to do so. Joining the right trust will allow us to continue to serve our unique community in the way that it deserves. Governors and staff have been carrying out due carefully considering the range of options, including diligence asking trust leaders many robust and challenging questions. On 5th June, our Governing Board agreed unanimously that Crofty Education Trust now seems to be the best fit for our school. A formal consultation period is now running until 30th September. Simon Hague, Crofty's Chief Executive Officer (CEO) will be leading a Parents Consultation Meeting in school on Monday 9th September @ 5pm. A reminder that children have already been consulted about joining a MAT. In the meantime, if you have any queries, please talk to Jenny Rainbow or Caroline Peers our Chair of Governors.
