


MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 16th May 2024

2024 Isles of Scilly (IOS) Residential Visit

We can confirm that we have been able to keep the total cost for the 2024 IOS residential visit the same as 2022, at £265. There is a subsidy for pupil premium (PP) children. Please speak Tamsyn or Edna in the School Office for further information about the PP subsidy. Please note that fundraising money is being used to cover the cost of a rib boat ride for all children. Household Support Fund - Another Reminder

The entitlement criteria for automatic payments from the Household Support Fund is changing. In order to be entitled to a payment from the Household Support Fund scheme in 2024, you must be responsible for at least one child and on 3rd June 2024 either: be entitled to Council Tax Support ORhave been placed in emergency accommodation by the Council. You will receive £80 per child. If you are already in receipt of Council Tax Support, then you don't have to do anything else – you will receive your payment automatically.
