Tempest are now coming into school next Wednesday 16th October for individual photographs. The photographer will be in school from 8.30am if you want family group photographs. If this day is your child's PE Day, your child can come to school in uniform on the day with PE kit to change into.

Breakfast Club Parking

Please note that we ask that parents do not park in the staff car park at any time, including when dropping children off at Breakfast Club. The playground gate is open from 7.45am so that children can be dropped off at the playground entrance, walking through the playground and up into school past the School Office. If you wish to go with your child/children into Breakfast Club (in the school hall) then you need to find alternative parking to the staff car park. A reminder that you can have a pass for your car, which allows you to park in Marazion Community Centre during drop off and pick up times. These passes are available from the School Office.

Minibus Fuel Charges

As you are probably aware, there are national campaigns highlighting the current funding crisis in schools, with schools facing significant cost pressures. Please note that, during this school year, we are now charging for fuel for the minibuses as part of our costings for school events/visits.

2024-25 Fundraising Events

To help us with cost pressures, classes are once again planning fundraising events across this school year. These funds helped to support a subsidy for all children who took part in a residential visit last year and we aim to do the same in 2024-25.

Nasal Flu Vaccinations 2024

We have the School Nursing Team coming in school for nasal flu vaccinations on Tuesday 5th November (the first week back after half term). All children from Reception to Year 6 are offered the vaccine. Letters about this will be emailed out next week (paper copies are available in the office). School provides swimming caps. Thanks. **Gym Sessions**: There are no gym sessions during this half term. **Optional PE Homework**: For October, we are asking you to go on an autumn walk and notice your favourite local plants, spaces and places.

This term our Vision and Aims Board focuses on Marazion School's SIXTH AIM: to support and celebrate the whole child to reveal local, national and global awareness, thinking about how this aim is reflected in our daily school life.
