Super Learning Day (SLD) - Next Monday 25th November

Next Monday is our autumn SLD and the theme is 'positive noticing.' We are thinking about how behaviour changes how we feel and if we change, everything changes. Children are discussing how we can 'positively notice' others and what they are doing, taking part in activities, including analysing the wisdom of Winnie the Pooh; building class 'recognition boards' and practising giving compliments in circle times.

2024 Marazion Parade of Lights / Lights Switch On - Friday 6th December

Everyone is invited to join the 'Marazion Parade of Lights' that will lead from St Michaels Mount to the Christmas Tree Big Switch On on Friday 6th of December at 6pm. The Parade of Lights will leave St Michael's Mount (SMM) at 3.45pm to walk across the Causeway towards Godolphin. If you want to join the parade, please pick up your child promptly at 3.15pm and head straight to SMM - there will be hot chocolate available. After that, in town, there are mince pies, carols and storytelling. Some children from Marazion School are singing by the tree from 5.20pm followed by carols led by Apollo Choir and the lights switch on at 6pm. Breage Band are playing around the Christmas tree too. There are also Christmas markets, more live music, Christmas trees, wreaths and lots of fun for the whole community.
