# Multi Academy Trust Consultation

You may remember that we began the process of exploring **multi-academy trusts (MAT)** some time ago. All schools are likely to be trust-led in the not-too-distant future and we are determined to make the right decision for Marazion and its community whilst we have the opportunity to do so. Joining the right trust will allow us to continue to serve our unique community in the way that it deserves. Governors and staff have been carrying out due diligence and carefully considering the range of options, including asking trust leaders many robust and challenging questions. On 5<sup>th</sup> June, our Governing Board agreed unanimously that **Crofty Education Trust** now seems to be the best fit for our school. We are therefore starting a formal **consultation period** on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July until 30<sup>th</sup> September. **Simon Hague**, Crofty's Chief Executive Officer (CEO) will be leading a **Parents Consultation Meeting in school on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September @ 5pm.** A reminder that children have already been consulted about joining a MAT.
