Dear Parents,

In/Out of School

Marazion School Reading Room (RR): Marazion School's RR is open again from next Monday 16th September. Children can choose to come into school and read for pleasure from 8.30-8.45am every day. Mercury are hosting the RR next week. School Visits/Events: Mitchell have their Adventure Day; Moana and Franklin have their Meet and Greet sessions and an Early Reading Meeting. Headlice - Treatment and Prevention

Please can you check your child's hair for headlice at least once a week. This is important in order to make sure that the source of infection is always managed. Local expert advice supports treatment with the Wet Combing Method - at least a weekly check of wet hair at hair wash time to detect headlice using a good quality detection comb and any conditioner. If live lice are detected this method should be used every 3 days for 2-3 weeks in order to prevent re-infection. If you find someone in your family has headlice, it is important to inform all close contacts. Thanks.

Nasal Flu Vaccinations 2024

We have the School Nursing Team coming in school for nasal flu vaccinations on Tuesday 5^{th} November. All children from Reception to Year 6 are offered the vaccine. Letters about this will be emailed out next week (paper copies are available in the office). Parents/carers need to register their consent for children to have the vaccine via the following link by Friday 1^{st} November https://www.kernowimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu. Please ensure you enter the full unique school reference code, which is EE111792.
